## **Administration**

### Car Pick Up

It is important that all parents involved in this service are attentive to the rules of the road. They are to only join the car pick up line from Henson street via Mason street. Parents are NOT to join the line from Davies Street. **U-turns in a school zone are illegal** and cause traffic congestion.

### **Morning Drop Off**

Morning drop off is for dropping off ONLY. Parents/Guardians/Carers are not to get out of their cars in the drop off Zone. All students should be able to get out of the car by themselves. Students should exit the car sensibly and as quickly as possible from the kerbside, to avoid traffic building up and for drop off to run smoothly. It is advised to say your goodbyes before you leave home, or just saying good bye and have a good day as the student is getting out of the car.

#### **Student Medical Information**

All medication must be brought to the school office by a parent and a medication form needs to be completed by the parent.

Katie is a young passionate 12 year old who sits in a wheel chair all day, everyday. She was someone who telt neglected, not wanted and especially alone. When Katie was 9 her parents suffered a terrible illness, which changed their lives forever. Now because of her parents tragic sickness, Katie lives with her grandrother. She walks, well rides on her wheelchair to school everyday with hope the next will be better. As a 12 year old, no one should experience the losses that Katie has suffered in her life. At school nothing improves and she never gets included in anything, even her teachers don't want her in their classes. She always knew she would never fit in, she didn't belong.

"Why, just why does it have to be me? There are 7 billion people in the world, even more and just it had to be me." She would question her self all the etime, uncontrolably. Where would the helpless 12 year old find inspiration. Where would she be influenced by other people to be the beautiful person she reality is? Where would she learn to express her feelings without getting them hur! As the days aim and the nights darken, katie sits in her wheelchair questioning herself, once more.

"What use do I have to this world? Will anyone ever miss me? Because of Katie's hope she continued to be the person she was. Soon her grandmather became conscious of Katie, her grades were dropping and her dejection grew. She asked Katie that day after school about her day and asked how things at school had been.

"It's all good she replied." I like school "she said in a non "meaningful voice." I am completely fine."

But in her heart she thought something different.

It was a normal school day at the cafeteria when a girl with blonde hair walked up to Katie, she was ready for the harmful comments she was about to embrace.

"Hi, my name is Laura, I am new to this School and I was wondering if we could be friends?"
