This app also allows parents to notify the school if your child is sick by completing the online Eform Absentee.

### **COVID UPDATE**

New guidelines from the NSW Government direct school communities to remain open as much as possible and children are expected at school everyday unless unwell during Term 1.

Changes in the manner to which positive cases at school will be handled. Please note the following:

- Parents / Carers must notify StMM's of a positive case in their family and follow all NSW Health Directives.
- StMM's will inform the School Community and share the particular Year Group / Cohort concerned.
- 3. For safety, we strongly recommend that Year Group / Cohort and other members of their household take a PCR test or Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) as a precaution.
- 4. The affected areas at the school will also be thoroughly cleaned.
- 5. Students who receive a negative result may return to school the following day.

### **RAT Kits**

### This Friday your child will bring home 4 RAT Kits for the next 2 weeks.

It is recommended that tests should be completed at home in the morning on Mondays and Wednesdays before attending school that week. Instructions are included in the kits detailing how to use the tests, check the results and dispose of the tests safely. If your child receives a positive RAT test, you need to:

- record the positive RAT result through the Service NSW website or Service NSW app
- Notify the school of the positive RAT (or a PCR test) result via school email ASAP
- follow <u>NSW Health advice</u> to isolate for 7 days.

Negative results do not need to be reported to Service NSW or to the school. Please also note that StMM's school staff will not be administering RATs to students.

### **Photo Permission**

From time to time photos and / or video footage of your child will be taken at school and school events. These photos and video footage may be used in the school newsletter, diocesan newsletter, in newspapers, brochures, advertising, websites or in publications.

If you **do not wish** for photos or videos of your child to be published or shown on the website please notify the school office in writing by Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2022.
