On Tuesday, 13th September children were taught about road safety and car safety.

While crossing the road get rid of any distractions like books, electronics or headphones and remember these rules: STOP, LOOK, LISTEN and THINK.

There is confusion between bike helmets and skateboard helmets. Always make sure to have the correct helmet. While you're putting on a bike helmet use the 2 finger rule. The first step is to put 2



fingers on top of your eyebrow, make a tick sign and place it under your ear if there's a gap, tighten it and place 2 fingers on your chin so there's no gap.

All parents should know this but every child under the age of 7 is supposed to have a booster seat so they don't have any injuries because when you put your

seatbelt on you need to have it across your hip and collarbone. All children under the age of 12 should not be in the front seat because of injuries because of their height and how weak their bones are.





When leaving the car, always go to the left where the footpath is so you don't get hit by a car and if you can't get an adult to open the door. By Charlie B and Jessica H
