ADVENT: Words of Wisdom from Fr Richard

In the first 1200 years of Christianity, the greatest feast was Holy Week leading up to the celebration of Easter and the resurrection of Christ. But in the 13th century, a new person entered the scene: Francis of Assisi felt we didn't need to wait for God to love us through the cross and resurrection. Francis understood that the whole thing started with love, and he popularised what we now take for granted as Christmas.

It makes sense that Christmas became the great celebratory feast of Christians because it basically says that it's good to be human, it's good to be on this earth. Remember, when we speak of Advent or preparing for Christmas, we are not just talking about waiting for the little baby Jesus to be born. That already happened 2,000 years ago. had a range of activities for students to participate in: Infants had musical statues, tennis, soccer and Simon Says and Primary had touch footy, tennis, soccer and


basketball.
