Important Information For 2023

Administration

School Hours

Parents are reminded that school commences at 8:40am and finishes at 3:00pm. It is important that students are here by 8:30am to begin classes at 8:40am. There is no supervision in the mornings before the 8:15am bell.

Parents are also reminded that they need to collect their child/ren from school at 3:00pm. If you are running late please contact the school office.

The school office is open from 8:15am to 3:15pm every day.

Student's Classes

It is a school policy that the make up of classes are revised at the end of Kindergarten (Early Stage One), Year Two (End of Stage One), Year Four (End of Stage Two) and as needed in other years. It must be remembered that the structure of our school facilitates a number of students working with a number of teachers. The decision of movement of students is at the discretion of the Principal.

Updating Parent Information

It is important for parents to ensure all information and contact details are up to date.

Please notify the school office via email if you have moved house or changed your contact number. It is also important to update your emergency contacts.

Who can I go home with?

If the occasion arises that you are unable to pick up your child/ren from school, please contact the school office advising who will be picking up your child/ren. Also a letter advising your child/rens class teacher if you know in advance as to who will be picking up your child.

School Uniforms

All uniforms must be worn neatly and correctly. It is expected that children have suitable hairstyles appropriate to their age and school expectations. Long hair must be tied back. Our Sun Safe programs require students to wear our school cap or hat when outside. No Hat No Play. These hats and caps are available at the school office. Sleeper earrings and stud earnings may be worn. Simple signet rings may also be worn. No expensive jewellery is to be worn at school.

Student Medical Information

Allergies

There are a number of children attending our school who have severe allergies to many different foods. This means that if these children come in contact with any food products, they will have a severe allergic reaction. We also ask that you remind your child/ren not to share their lunch or any other food with another child.

Asthma

If your child/ren suffer from asthma or have a medical condition and you have not informed the school office, could you please do so as soon as possible.

For example, if your child suffers from asthma, please supply an updated Asthma Action Plan from your child's doctor.

All medication must be brought to the school office by a parent and a medication form needs to be completed by the parent.

School Newsletter & Update

For all our new families, especially our Kindy families, the school 'Bulletin' is printed every second Wednesday which is a four page newsletter and sent home with the eldest child. The 'Update' is a small newsletter which is only uploaded onto Compass & the school Website.

Crunch and Sip

Just a reminder that Crunch and Sip is a break during class when students can refuel on fruit or vegetables and rehydrate on water. The break assists students with physical and mental performance, and concentration in the classroom.



Reading Diary

Every student at StMM's is expected to read each night and record their efforts in the Reading Diary. Setting aside a time to read each night at home is an excellent routine to establish before students enter high school. If parents feel their child is responsible (Yrs 5 & 6) the student may do the recording and sign off.



Parents are reminded to update your child's class on the Flexi Schools app before ordering lunches. This will ensure that lunches are delivered to the correct class in time for lunch.


Lowes Uniforms

StMM's Car Drop Off & Pick Up

10 STEPS TO A SUCCESSFUL SCHOOL DROP OFF

- 1. All children should be ready for their school day before you reach the drop off zone.
- 2. If your child is not ready to get out of your car please do not enter the drop off zone.
- 3. If you have a child that had a meltdown en route to school please pull over somewhere private and address the issue.
- 4. In the interest of public safety do not attempt the double play of talking on your phone and driving while negotiating school drop off.
- 5. Do not get out of your car.
- 6. If your child is carrying a large backpack plus equipment, please make arrangements to help them unload from the safety of the Parish car park.
- 7. If you are in a hurry don't honk your horn or attempt to squeeze into a line opening.
- 8. If your child's teacher is on duty please resist the urge to speak about your child.
- 9. Never, ever park in the drop off line.
- 10. Remain calm and patient at all times.

In review, the perfect drop off scenario should be as follows..

- 1. Kids are dressed
 - 2. Backpacks are ready on the seat
 - 3. Approach the drop off zone fully alert
 - 4. Hands on steering wheel
- 5. Eyes forward when it's your turn for car unloading
- 6. You initiate the "bye bye, have a great day" sequence
- 7. Children unload swiftly and with all of their belongings
- 8. Ease away from the curb
- 9. Drive away from the school
- 10. Drive away slowly taking the safety of our children into consideration

Practices for Afternoon Car Pick Up

We have been informed by police & the Parking Patrol Officers of the Holroyd Area that we only have control of the StMM's school block on Henson Street. This means the following:

- The only dedicated Car Pick-Up queue is the length of the school block in Henson Street
- Joining this queue must be done following all road and traffic rules including signage
- Parents/Carers are now able to join the Car Pick-up queue via Davies Street & Henson Street
- Parents/Carers are to ensure they give way correctly taking into account all signs & road rules
- Cars that are lined up across from the school block in Henson Street will be booked. The police view this as double parking
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Aspect to follow for Car Pick-Up

- Have your number visible for the teacher to call
- Remain calm and patient at all times
- Adults to remain in cars
- Follow all road rules

 Either go to the App Store and search flexischools – it is free to download or log in via your computer www.flexischools.com.au and register




How do I register for a Flexischools account?

You can register by following these steps:

- You can access the service at by clicking the "Register Now" button below
- Submit your email address to create an account.
- Go to your Inbox and open the registration email from Flexischools.
- Click on the link provided (or copy and paste the link in a new internet browser window).
- Follow the registration process, creating a password and completing your personal details.
- Add users to your account. This could be your students or yourself if you are a staff member, Alumni or friend of the school.

Helpful Hints: If you have a Senior Student and you would like them to be able to login to see their balance or place online orders for the canteen, please enter their email address during the setup process and they will be sent a registration email.

Flexi schools will then ask you to set up your students and put some money into your account.



Flexi schools will then ask you to select St Margaret Mary's School and nominate your child/children's class(es).

Once this is done you will be able to make your order.

Ordering is simple and you may order in advance. Warning: All orders must be in before 9.00am
