Principal's Message

Parents and Carers

A number of our classes have been watching webinars from the Australian Government's eSafety Commissioner looking at responsible online behaviour. We are doing this to help your children safely navigate their digital world and educate them to avoid harmful online experiences. Your support and guidance can give your children the confidence to make sound decisions online — and ask for help when they need it. The following information can be found on the eSafety Commissioner's Site.

3 key strategies

- Be engaged, open and supportive
- Set some rules
- Use the available technology

For Children aged 5 to 12, it is important to:

- Keep the computer or device in an area of your home that can be supervised. And check in regularly with your child to see what they are viewing.
- Stay engaged with their online activity. Consider setting up your own accounts with the sites they use most so you can see how they work and understand the risks.
- Explore the online world with them to help establish that this is not just a solitary activity. Play games and do a creative project together.
- Think about social media readiness. Most social media sites require users to be at least 13 years of age before they can register.
- Encourage respect and empathy. Teach them to avoid sharing or posting things that may upset others and start building resilience. Teach your child that there are ways they can deal with material that worries or frightens them. This includes immediately telling you of any concerns or uncomfortable material.

Review your rules as your child grows older

Be clear about how much time they can spend online, the apps they can use, the websites they can visit and what they can share or post online.

Technology tips for parents

- Ensure your own devices are protected by a password or pin, so your child cannot accidentally come across inappropriate content. If you are thinking about giving them their own tablet or smartphone, check out are they old enough?
- Use parental control tools appropriate for the age and experience of your child. Be upfront about this and get your child on board. Let them know that these can be reviewed and changed as they get older and they continue to demonstrate responsible behaviour. Consider installing a 'child-friendly' search engine that will allow them to explore a limited number of sites.
- A simple rule for StMM's students is: Parents are to have access to all the student's online activity and there is no reason why a child's password is not shared with a parent.

COVID-19 Information

Sick Leave & Documentation

We ask all our families to follow the guidelines below as we value the well-being and health of the St Margaret Mary's Community.

- Currently, no student should attend school if they are unwell (Doctor's Certificate).
- Each student who is absent from school or who has been sent home because they have flu-like symptoms, need to see a doctor or must have a COVID-19 test.
- A negative COVID-19 test result must be provided to the school before a student can come back to school. The notification can be a NSW Health or COVID-19 Testing Centre letter, SMS or email and / or a medical certificate.
- Students are not able to return to school until they return a negative COVID-19 result and are symptom free.
