### **School Hours**

Parents are reminded that lessons begin at 8:40am and finish at 3:00pm. Children should be at school by 8:30am.

There is no supervision in the mornings before the 8:15am bell. Between 8:15am until 8:30am it is a walk and talk time only. Students are reminded that there is to be NO running or ball games in the playground in the mornings.

Parents are also reminded that they need to collect their child/ren from school at 3:00pm. If you are running late please contact the school office. The school office is open from 8:15am to 3:15pm every day.

#### **Student Medical Information**

If your child/ren suffer from asthma or has a medical condition (eg Allergies) and you have not informed the school office, could you please do so as soon as possible.

For example, if your child suffers for asthma, please supply an updated Asthma Action Plan from your child's doctor, along with ventolin & spacer.

All medication must be brought to the school office by a parent and a medication form needs to be completed by the parent.

## **Allergies**


At StMM's we have a number of children attending our school who have severe allergies to many different foods. This means that if these children come in contact with any food products they will have a severe allergic reaction. We also ask that you remind your child/ren not to share their lunch or any other food with another child.

### **School Uniforms**

All uniforms must be worn neatly and correctly. All hairstyles should be appropriate to the students age and the schools expectations. Long hair must be tied back. Our Sun Safe program requires students to wear our school cap or hat when outside: No Hat No Play. These hats and caps are available at the school office. Sleeper earrings and stud earrings may be worn. Simple signet rings may also be worn. No expensive jewellery is to be worn at school.



Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct sports shoes and socks. The school sports shoes should be predominately white and socks should be white with a fold down top. Parents are asked to ensure that students have the correct uniform

**Afternoon Pick Up** 

As from next week (Monday 15<sup>th</sup> February), all parents picking up Kindy students from parent pick up will need to line up with all other parents, as kindy students will be dismissed along with all grades in the top COLA area for afternoon dismissal.

# **Entering and Exiting the School for Students**

There are two ways for students to enter and exit the school in the mornings and afternoons from now on.

#### **Morning Arrivals**

- 1. Top Church Gate
- 2. Car Drop off

#### Afternoon Dismissal

- 1. Top Church Gate
- 2. Car Pick-up

Please note the Year 2 Gates will not be open for general traffic as a matter of safety.

We have been informed by Police & the Parking Patrol Officers of the Holroyd Area that we only have control of StMM's school block on Henson Street.

This means the following:

- We will aim to start Car Pick-Up at 3.00pm
- The only dedicated Car Pick-Up queue is the length of the school block in Henson Street
- Joining this queue must be done following all road and traffic rules including signage
- Parents/Carers are now able to join the Car Pick-Up queue via Davies Street & Henson St
- Parents/Carers are to ensure they give way correctly taking into account all signs & road rules
- Cars that are lined up across from the school block in Henson Street will be booked. The police view this as double parking.

#### Aspects to follow for Car Pick -Up

- Stagger your arrival between 3.00pm and 3.30pm
- Have your number visible for the teacher to call
- Remain calm and patient at all times
- Adults to remain in cars
- Follow all road rules


## **Cross Country Reminders.**

#### Dear parents and carers

Please find below the Annual Diocesan fees schedule for 2021. The fees remained unchanged from 2020, a reflection of Bishop Vincent Long's aim of making our Catholic schools as affordable as possible for families.

School-based fees have also remained unchanged. School-based fees cover the costs of things such as technology and school administration.

School fees are generally billed in instalments during Terms 1, 2 and 3. The fee is made up of three main parts:

#### 1. Diocesan tuition fee

These are set by Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta and are the same for every school. There are significant sibling discounts for families with more than one child at a Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta school (it does not have to be the same school).

Those discounts and a list of the annual Diocesan tuition fees for 2021 are outlined below 2021 Diocesan tuition fee schedule (per year)

#### **Diocesan Building Levy** 2.

This fee is set by Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta and is the same for every school. The annual Diocesan building levy for 2021 is \$822. There is only one Diocesan building levy per family with one or more children in a Parramatta Diocesan school or at St Dominic's College, Kingswood and it is billed in instalments over the first 3 terms of the year. A sibling discount of up to 50% applies to families with children within the bordering Archdiocese of Sydney and Dioceses of Wollongong and Broken Bay.

#### School-based fees 3.

These are determined by the school according to the needs of that school and billable for each child. School-based fees are often called 'resource fees' or 'activity fees'. These fees help schools cover the costs of things like teaching resources, technology, excursions etc.

This fee varies between schools. Please contact the school to find out more about their schoolbased fees. Although it varies from school to school, as a guide, the Diocesan tuition fee represents roughly half the overall fee per year.

#### Here's how we can help

We appreciate that from time to time, some families experience financial challenges. As well as sibling discounts, confidential fee support is available through the following means:

#### Flexible payment options

Families enrolled in CEDP schools are offered flexible payment options at the start of each year. These options provide opportunities to select a payment plan that best suits you. Payments can be made by direct debit, debit, or credit card, or BPay on a weekly, fortnightly or monthly basis at no additional charge.

#### Fee assistance

We understand financial circumstances can change and that these changes can impact on families. Please speak with your school principal confidentially if your family experiences financial difficulty or hardship so an appropriate arrangement can be made.

#### **Bishop Manning Support Fund**

In addition to fee assistance programs, the Bishop Manning Support Fund is available to families who experience challenges meeting the cost of school fees due to financial hardship. Further information is available at the Bishop Manning Support Fund page of the CEDP website.

#### **Byallawa Co-contribution Scheme**

The Byallawa co-contribution scheme provides assistance to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander families to ensure a quality Catholic education is affordable and accessible. Further information is available on our Byallawa Co-contribution Scheme page of the CEDP website.
