# Principal's Message

Dear Parents, Carers, Boys & Girls,

The following short tips on raising caring kids is based on research in human development from Harvard School of Education which clearly shows that the seeds of empathy, caring, and compassion are present from early in life, but that to become caring, ethical people, children need adults to help them at every stage of childhood to nurture these seeds into full development. Below are a set of guideposts to raising caring, respectful, and ethical children, along with tips for putting them into action.

- 1. Work to develop caring, loving relationships with your kids: Children learn caring and respect when they are treated that way. When our children feel loved, they also become attached to us. TRY THIS: Regular time together; Meaningful conversation
- 2. <u>Be a strong moral role model and mentor:</u> Children learn ethical values and behaviours by watching our actions and the actions of other adults they respect. Children will listen to our teaching when we walk the talk. <u>TRY THIS:</u> Be of Service; Honesty and humility; take care of yourself.
- 3. <u>Make caring for others a priority and set high ethical expectations:</u> It's very important that children hear from their parents and caretakers that caring about others is a top priority and that it is just as important as their own happiness. <u>TRY THIS:</u> A clear message; Prioritize caring; Encourage kids to "work it out."
- 4. <u>Provide opportunities for children to practice caring and gratitude:</u> Children need practice caring for others and being grateful—it's important for them to express appreciation for the many people who contribute to their lives. <u>TRY THIS:</u> Real responsibilities; Make caring & justice a focus; Express thanks.
- 5. <u>Expand your child's circle of concern:</u> Our challenge is help children learn to have empathy and care about someone outside the family they care for. <u>TRY THIS:</u> Children facing challenges; Listening.
- 6. <u>Promote Children to be ethical thinkers and positive change-makers: are</u> naturally interested in ethical questions and are often interested in taking leadership roles to improve their communities. They want to be forces for good. <u>TRY THIS:</u> Taking action; Doing "with."; Thinking out loud with your child.
- 7. <u>Help children develop self-control and manage feelings effectively:</u> Often the ability to care for others is overwhelmed by anger, shame, envy, or other negative feelings. <u>TRY</u> <u>THIS:</u> Identifying feelings; 3 steps to self-control; Resolving conflicts. Clear limits. Use authority wisely to set clear boundaries. Explain how your limits are based on a reasonable and loving concern for your child's welfare.

Raising a caring, respectful, ethical child is hard work, but it is the work God wants us to get better at. If we all followed the 7 simple tips, we will end up with a better future for our

Students were given the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy. The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$30 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion.

3D Printing, WOW does that sound interesting to you? Well in 6Blue we had the opportunity to create 3D keyrings




using a program called Tinkercad. We created layers, and used different digital shapes and
